Time

To realize the value of ONE YEAR, ask a student who failed a grade.

To realize the value of ONE MONTH, ask a mother who gave birth to a premature baby.

To realize the value of ONE HOUR, ask the businessman whose flight was delayed an hour.

To realize the value of ONE MINUTE, ask the man who had the heart attack in the restaurant.

To realize the value of ONE SECOND, ask the person who barely missed a head-on collision in a car accident.

To realize the value of ONE MILLISECOND, ask the Olympic swimmer who missed qualifying by 0.1 second.

Time is often represented by a straight line drawn on a page. We call this a timeline.

To get a grasp of what the eternality of God means, when you have drawn your timeline, you must picture God as the whole page on which the line is drawn.

James 4:13-15 - Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."
