Follow the Example of Jesus

Muhammad, the founder of Islam, reportedly killed many who disagreed with him.

Krishna, of the Hindu faith, allegedly murdered his uncle. Siddhartha Gautama, the founder of Buddhism, abandoned his wife and son to achieve "enlightenment."

Jesus never killed anyone or abandoned his followers to achieve his goal.

Philippians 2:8-11 - 8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus' example should inspire all of us to follow in his path and lead others to eternal life in Jesus.

A study once disclosed that if both Mom and Dad attend church regularly, 72% of their children remain faithful. If only Dad, 55% remain faithful. If only Mom, 15%.
