Legacy of Faith – Oakland Church of Christ

The city of Oakland was a small town in rural Fayette County, Tennessee, and there was no local Church of Christ available for people to worship. The Oakland Church of Christ began with a series of meetings between 1945-1950. These meetings were mostly tent meetings with ministers Louis Hale and J.A. McNutt serving as preachers. The Oakland Church of Christ started with 10 members in 1953 and experienced growth to 73 members in 1986.

In 1953, the church raised \$1,000 and then borrowed only an additional \$3,500 for construction, and much of the construction was completed by church members to reduce the total cost of the structure.¹ Due to congregational growth, additional classrooms were added in 1964, and the final editions were proposed in 1977.

The Oakland Church of Christ has a long history of supporting mission work both locally and internationally. The Oakland Church supported the work of Malcolm Parsley in Korea at the Kimpo Church of Christ in Seoul, South Korea. The church also sponsored the work of Don Greene in the South Pacific areas of Singapore and Malaysia. The Oakland Church of Christ also supported work of spreading the Gospel in Pakistan starting in 1971 with the Charles Jones family. The Oakland church continues its work in missions with Curry Montague in Hungary and David French in Zambia. The Oakland Church of Christ helped establish the first African American Church of Christ in Fayette County in 1975, the Macon Road Church of Christ. Several members and elders of our church were present at their opening service.

The Oakland Church has a legacy of 71 years of serving the Lord. Let us take a moment to reflect on the saints who established our foundation here at Oakland. Today – let us honor and remember the legacy of faith passed down to us as we continue the Lord's work here at the Oakland church. Our work here is not done. We have a history and legacy of faith and service to pass on to this generation and community.
