### **Ignoring the Cancer**

John woke up one morning not feeling well. It was his 50th birthday, and as he looked in the mirror, he noticed a change. His face looked haggard, and it seemed over the last few weeks his breath was becoming shorter, and he had some chest pain. However, John was not going to let anything spoil his special day. He grabbed his pack of cigarettes and lit up his first cigarette of the day and went on his way preparing for work.
