Seven Steps of Temptation

1. Entrance of the Thought This is the initial moment when a tempting thought enters your mind. It is not a sin to have thoughts; everyone experiences them.

2. Entertainment of the Thought This is when you begin to dwell on the thought, considering it more deeply. This is the first mistake, as it can lead to further temptation.

3. Examination of the Thought At this stage, you analyze the thought and its implications, weighing the pros and cons.

4. Enjoyment of the Thought Here, you start to bond with the thought, finding pleasure in it, which can lead to a stronger desire to act on it.

5. Experiencing the Thought This is when you take action based on the thought, moving from contemplation to actual sin.

6. Excusing the Sin After acting on the temptation, you may try to justify your actions, shifting blame away from yourself.

7. Engagement in Sin Finally, you fully commit to the sin, which can lead to further consequences and a cycle of temptation.

James 1:12-15 - Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him. 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. 14 But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.
