History of the Oakland Church of Christ

Did you know there is a written history of the Oakland Church of Christ in our library?

The Oakland Church of Christ began with a series of meetings between 1945-1950. These meetings were mostly tent meetings with ministers Louis Hale and J.A. McNutt serving as preachers. The Oakland Church of Christ started with 10 members in 1953.

In 1953, the church raised \$1,000 and then borrowed only an additional \$3,500 for construction, and much of the construction was completed by church members to reduce the total cost of the structure. Due to congregational growth, additional classrooms were added in 1964, and the final editions were proposed in 1977.

The Oakland Church of Christ helped with the establishment of the first African American congregation in Fayette County, the Macon Road Church of Christ, and members attended the church's dedication service on August 15, 1975.

Let us NEVER FORGET the love, legacy, example, and fellowship of those who went before us with vision and zeal for the Lord.
