The Body of Christ

• 1 Corinthians 12:12-13 - ¹² For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ¹³ For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

Genuine Love

• Romans 12:9 - ⁹ Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good.

A Holy People

- James 4:4 ⁴ You adulterous people! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
- 1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.




Love One Another

Serve the Lord

• Romans 12:11 - ¹¹ Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord.

Service in Humility

• **Philippians 2:3-4** - ³ Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. ⁴ Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

Love in Deed and Truth

• 1 John 3:17-18 - . ¹⁷ But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? ¹⁸ Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

Hope, Tribulation, Prayer

• Romans 12:12 - ¹² Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

Hope

• Ephesians 4:4 - ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call.

Patience

• Ephesians 4:1-3 - I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, ² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, ³ eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Love in Action

• Romans 12:13 - ¹³ Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.
