



Make a Joyful Noise

- **Psalm 100:1** - Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth!

Give Thanks to Your Creator

- **Psalm 139:13-14(a)** - ¹³ For you formed my inward parts;
you knitted me together in my mother's womb.
¹⁴ I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

Make a Joyful Noise to the Lord

- **Psalm 32:11** - Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!
- **Psalm 95:1** - Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

Make a Joyful Noise Bring Down the Walls

- **Joshua 6:16** - ¹⁶ And at the seventh time, when the priests had blown the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, “Shout, for the Lord has given you the city.
- **Joshua 6:20** - ²⁰ So the people shouted, and the trumpets were blown. As soon as the people heard the sound of the trumpet, the people shouted a great shout, and the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they captured the city.

Serve the Lord with Gladness

- Psalm 100:2(a) - Serve the Lord with gladness!

Do All Things Without Grumbling

- **Philippians 2:14-15** - ¹⁴ Do all things without grumbling or disputing, ¹⁵ that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,
- **1 Peter 4:9** - *Be* hospitable to one another without grumbling.

Come Into His Presence with Singing

- **Psalm 100:2(b)** - Come into his presence with singing!
- **Psalm 95:2** - Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving
;let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!

Know that the Lord, He is God!

- **Psalm 100:3 (a)** - Know that the Lord, he is God!
- **Psalm 46:10** - “Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!”

It is He Who Made Us, and We are His

- **Psalm 100:3 (b)** - It is he who made us, and we are his...
- **Isaiah 64:8** - 8 But now, O Lord, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand.

We are His People, and the Sheep of His Pasture

- **Psalm 100:3 (c)** - ...we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
- **John 10:27-30** - 27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. 30 I and the Father are one.”

Enter His Gates with Thanksgiving, and His Courts with Praise!

- **Psalm 100:4 (a)** - 4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise!

Factors of True Worship

1. Thanksgiving
2. Praise/Singing
3. Prayer
4. Recognizing and Acknowledging God's Love and Faithfulness

Search Me O God

Psalm 139:23-24:

²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart!

Try me and know my thoughts!

²⁴ And see if there be any grievous way in me,
and lead me in the way everlasting!

Give Thanks to Him; Bless His Name!

- **Psalm 100:4 (b)** - Give thanks to him; bless his name!
- **1 Thessalonians 5:18** - ... 18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

The Lord's Steadfast Love

- **Psalm 100:5** - For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.
