8 Questions Welcoming Churches Ask

- 1. Are our members inviting others?
- 2. Does our website communicate to guests?
- 3. Are our members friendly to guests or to members only?
- 4. Is our facility clean, tidy, and safe?
- 5. Are there barriers to worship?
- 6. Are we speaking a foreign language?
- 7. Do we follow up with guests in a timely manner?
- 8. Do we have clear next steps?

IN THE LETTER TO CORINTH...

- 1. The word "edification" appears many times 1 Corinthians 14:4,5, 12
- 2. A guiding principle to govern any assembly: "Let all things be done for edification"
- 1 Corinthians 14:26 26 What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

IN THE LETTER TO CORINTH...

- 1. Paul said he sought to be understood
 - 1 Corinthians 14:19 19 Nevertheless, in church I would rather speak five words with my mind in order to instruct others, than ten thousand words in a tongue.
- 2. He earlier wrote that he did not use "lofty speech or wisdom"
 - 1 Corinthians 2:1 And I, when I came to you, brothers, did not come proclaiming to you the testimony of God with lofty speech or wisdom.

Member Participation

- **Hebrews 10:24-25** And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
- **Galatians 6:9-10** And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. ¹⁰ So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.
- **Ephesians 5:19-21** addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, ²⁰ giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

- 1. Paul gave instructions designed to create order
 - "For God is not a God of confusion but of peace." 1 Corinthians 14:33
- 2. His final charge: "Let all things be done decently and in order." 1 Corinthians 14:40 (NKJV)

Peace in the Congregation

- 1 Corinthians 1:10-11 I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment. 11 For it has been reported to me by Chloe's people that there is quarreling among you, my brothers.
- Romans 12:12-13 Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. 13 Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.
